

BY-LAWS OF THE CRICKET ILLAWARRA ASSOCIATION

(Illawarra Cricket Association)

The terms and definitions used throughout these By-Laws are those which apply to the Constitution of the Cricket Illawarra Association Incorporated.

BY-LAW 1 – CLUB COLOURS

(a) All affiliated Clubs must register their official Club colours with the Association. Such Club colours cannot be changed without having the change accepted as a change of By-Law at a general meeting.

(b) The registered colours of the affiliated Clubs are:

(c) The official colours of the Association are Scarlet & White.

(d) Affiliated Associations may also register their official colours with the Association.

BY-LAW 2 – GENERAL AND COMPETITION ADMINISTRATION

(a) The management of competitions conducted by the Association shall be vested in various Competition Sub-Committees, elected / appointed annually and having delegated authority under Incorporation Rules.

(b) All affiliated Clubs and Bodies competing in competitions shall be bound and abide by, the specific documents covering the

- 1) administrative terms, conditions and regulations
- 2) respective general competition regulations
- 3) respective competition format playing conditions

(c) All administrative and playing condition documents shall be reviewed annually as determined by the Association Management Committee.

BY-LAW 3 – BEHAVIOUR AND CONDUCT

- (a) All matters relating to the behaviour and conduct of all the Association members, affiliated Clubs and Bodies membership, and support staff (including parents) will be handled in accordance with the respective;
 - 1) Constitution
 - 2) Member Protection Policy document
 - 3) Code of Conduct document (Grade)
 - 4) Junior Code of Behaviour documents
- (b) Behaviour and Conduct documents shall be reviewed periodically as determined by the Association Management Committee.

BY-LAW 4 – ALTERATION TO BY-LAWS

- (a) Alteration to the By-Laws of the Association can only be affected at a general meeting of the Association of which notice has been duly given.
- (b) The conditions applying to an alteration of the By-Laws of the Association are those which apply to an alteration of the Constitution of the Association.
